Thank you for agreeing to review the attached paper, which has been submitted for publication in the *Journal of Latin American Geography (JLAG)*. We would appreciate receiving your evaluation, comments, and any anonymous recommendations to the authors within 30 days of receipt. Your review should be submitted via the [Digital Commons](#) website using the link provided in the invitation emailed to you.

AIMS AND SCOPE OF THE JOURNAL

During your review, please recall that *JLAG* seeks to publish original and well-written manuscripts focusing on geographical and interdisciplinary scholarship on Latin America and the Caribbean and the diaspora from this region. It invites theoretically robust, empirically rich, and policy relevant research from across human and environmental geography. The journal aims to provide a forum through which to showcase current academic and policy research on geographical processes and their implications in the region, and to advance debates on the theoretical perspectives and methodological practices in Latin American geography.

PEER REVIEW AND CONFIDENTIALITY

This is to be a “double blind” review, in which the reviewer and author are not identified to one another. As such, please do not include your name or other identifying information in your comments to the author, and please respect confidentiality about the manuscript and review process.

GENERAL REVIEW GUIDELINES

JLAG does not use a specific form for reviews. Instead, please upload your review as a text file, a Microsoft Word (or RTF) file, or as a PDF file through [Digital Commons](#), using the link included in the invitation emailed to you. Through this link you may also upload confidential comments that only the editors will see.

When reviewing the paper, please consider the following general questions:

- Is the paper appropriate to the aims, scope, and quality standards of *JLAG*?
- Is the title appropriate?
- Does the paper identify and represent an original, interesting, and/or meaningful contribution to geographical research on Latin America and the Caribbean and/or the diaspora from this region?
- Are its objectives clearly articulated?

- Is the paper situated within the appropriate theoretical and/or empirical literature and does it adequately engage with and discuss this literature?
- Are its methods adequately described and appropriate to the stated objectives?
- Are its conclusions consistent with the objectives, and well supported by the data?
- Is the paper well-organized, and clearly and concisely written?
- Are figures and tables appropriate to the content of the paper, accurate, and well-designed?

OVERALL EVALUATION

Finally, you will be asked for an overall evaluation and recommendation. You may consider that the paper should be:

- a) Accepted in its current form
- b) Accepted following minor revisions
- c) Revised and resubmitted
- d) Rejected
